Canine Friends is a nationwide organisation. There are 30 regions. Each region has at least one Liaison officer (LOs). All 30 LOs report to either a North Island or South Island Field Officer.

Each region reports to the National Committee which is based in the Wellington region. The National Committee is responsible for setting and maintaining national standards, codes of conduct and necessary operational policies. All regions will observe the national standards, codes of conduct and any operational policies set by the National Committee.

Canine Friends consists of members. Members can be active, qualified active, or honorary.

Honorary Members are elected by resolution at the Annual General Meeting. Honorary Members are exempt from payment of subscriptions and enjoy full member privileges.

Committee meetings are held once a month. Quorum shall be five members. The current elected officers are:
