

Canine Friends Vox Pop

Canine Friends visited The Bubble at Te Herenga Waka - Victoria University of Wellington the week before the assessment period, 12 October 2020. The purpose of the visit was to help students manage stress associated with Trimester 2 assessments.

Canine Friends dogs and their handlers visited over a period of 12 hours. Four visits occurred on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday between 11am and 2pm. Approximately 500 interactions occurred during that time.

55 students completed a Vox Pop (a quick two question survey) conducted by a Bubble Leader during the Canine Friends visit.

We asked students if they enjoyed their visit. All 55 respondents reported enjoying their visit with the Canine Friends.
